

2012 Bible Reading Plan – Week 25

Monday, July 2: 2 Kings 20-21 Psalm 142 Romans 4

Scriptural Prayer: As it is written: “I have made you a father of many nations.” He is our father in the sight of God, in whom he believed—the God who gives life to the dead and calls into being things that were not. Being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised. This is why “it was credited to him as righteousness.” (Romans 4: 17, 21-22)

My Prayer: Do you feel discouraged about the unanswered prayer? Let’s fix our eyes on our God who gives life to the dead and creates things out of nothing. Ask God to strengthen our faith while we are waiting so that we will receive God’s promise and give glory to Him.

Healing Prayer: *Created things out of nothing (Romans 4:17)*

Are you in a hopeless situation or have lack of resources? Your illness hasn’t been healed yet? Come and call on our God who gives life to the dead and create things out of nothing. You shall experience the miracles in your life.

Tuesday, July 3: 2 Kings 22-23 Psalm 143 Romans 5

Scriptural Prayer: Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God. Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope. And hope does not put us to shame, because God’s love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us. (Romans 5:1-5)

My Prayer: May the Holy Spirit pour down the love into our heart and help us to know that no matter what, we are here because of God’s grace. Therefore, we can produce perseverance, character and hope.

Healing Prayer: *Christ died for ungodly (Romans 5:6-11)*

When we cannot love people, let’s meditate on the love from the Lord that He loves us so much and died for us. Thus, we can reconcile with people with a grateful heart.

Wednesday, July 4: 2 Kings 24-25 Psalm 144 Romans 6

Scriptural Prayer: Or don’t you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. (Romans 6:3-4)

My Prayer: May the Holy Spirit remind us that we were baptized into Christ Jesus. We are new creatures and free from sins.

Healing Prayer: *Evil desires (Romans 6:12)*

Let’s ask the Holy Spirit to work on us and help us to free from evil desires. Commit ourselves to be holy instrument and be used by God.

Thursday, July 5: 1 Chronicles 1-2 Psalm 145 Romans 7

Scriptural Prayer: What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God’s law, but in my sinful nature a slave to the law of sin. (Romans 7:24-25)

My Prayer: Thanks to the Lord! Even though there are struggles in our hearts, we can ask God to help us grow our inner men and be willing to obey God. Then, we can be free from law of sin and bondages.

Healing Prayer: *The Lord is gracious and compassionate (Psalm 145:8-9)*

Thank God for creating us in this World and for being gracious to us. He never gets angry at us due to our sins and weakness. God always chooses to love His children with grace and compassion. Let us sing praise to Him and His almighty works!

Friday, July 6: 1 Chronicles 3-4 Psalm 146 Romans 8

Scriptural Prayer: In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God. (Romans 8:26-27)

My Prayer: Let's give thanks to the Spirit who intercedes for us through wordless groans and brings us the power of God and answers. Let's open our mind and heart and call out to the Holy Spirit to work among us greatly!

Healing Prayer: Abba Father (Romans 8:15-16)

Are you usually afraid of coming before God? Have you ever tried to call God "Abba Father"? Today, try to call Him your "Abba Father" and you will receive the real father's love from Him!

Saturday, July 7: 1 Chronicles 5-8 Psalm 147

Scriptural Prayer: Sing to the LORD with grateful praise; make music to our God on the harp. He provides food for the cattle and for the young ravens when they call. His pleasure is not in the strength of the horse, nor his delight in the legs of the warrior; the LORD delights in those who fear him, who put their hope in his unfailing love. (Psalm 147, 9-11)

My Prayer: Let's ask God to give us grateful heart. Let us make music to our God because our hope is in Him. He even supplies the earth with rain and provides food for the young ravens, let alone us? Let's look upon His grace and love.

Healing Prayer: Put hope in His unfailing love (Psalm 147:11-14)

Thank God for strengthening the bar of the gates (Church) and bless every single of His child. He supplies us with the finest of wheat and gives us joy! Let's proclaim that River of Life Christian Church is a church which fears the Lord and put hope in His unfailing love.
