

2012 Bible Reading Plan – Week 43

Monday, Nov 5: Jeremiah 19-20 Psalms 81 Hebrews 7

Scriptural Prayer: Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them. (Hebrews 7:25)

My Prayer: Thank our Jesus Christ for being our priest, who always intercedes for us and for the salvation. Let us come to our God and cry out to Him boldly, ask Him to save those family members who have not been saved yet.

Healing Prayer: Open wide your mouth (Psalm 81:10)

We often have desires for worldly things, but we don't open our mouths to ask for the Kingdom of God. Today, let us make change our minds and ask God's spirit to pour down on us so that we may be filled with the Holy Spirit. Each of us can experience spiritual breakthrough and receive the gift of speaking tongues.

Tuesday, Nov 6: Jeremiah 21-22 Psalms 82-83 Hebrews 8

Scriptural Payer: This is the covenant I will establish with the people of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. I will put my laws in their minds and write them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. No longer will they teach their neighbor, or say to one another, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest. (Hebrews 8:10-11)

My Prayer: Dear Lord, please remember your new covenant with us and forgive our wickedness. We are your people, from the least to the greatest; we will want to know you more.

Healing Prayer: Do what is just and right. (Jeremiah 22:1-3)

Let us pray for the 2012 Election and ask God's just and righteousness will be revealed in the process of the Election. Let us also pray for the government that they can do what is just and right. Remember the fatherless or the widows and rescue people from the hand of their oppressors.

Wednesday, Nov 7: Jeremiah 23-24 Psalms 84 Hebrews 9

Scriptural Prayer: How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death,[a] so that we may serve the living God! (Hebrews 9:14)

My Prayer: Dear God, please cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so we can serve you, our living God. Purify us to be the precious vessels.

Healing Prayer: Mediator (Hebrews 9:14-15)

Today, let us mediate Jesus who is the mediator between us and God. Because of Him, we can come to serve Him as a new person with a new heart.

Thursday, Nov 8: Jeremiah 25-26 Psalms 85-86 Hebrews 10

Scriptural Prayer: So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised. For, In just a little while, he who is coming will come and will not delay.” (Hebrews 10:35-37)

My Prayer: Dear God, I am willing to follow your will. Help me not to throw away my confidence when serving you and know in just a little while, you will come and will not delay.

Healing Prayer: Do not give up meetings (Hebrews 10:25)

Sometimes we are so swamped in works or house works and we feel lazy to go to church or cell group meetings. Let us not make this a habit, but spur one another on toward love and good deeds.

Friday, Nov 9: Jeremiah 27-28 Psalms 87-88 Hebrews 11

Scriptural Prayer: Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. (Hebrews 11:1,6)

My Prayer: Dear God, please increase the capacity of my faith and activate it. Let us be sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see. With our faith, we will experience His promise, which He rewards those who earnestly seek Him.

Healing Prayer: Because of faith (Hebrews 11:1-40)

Let us learn from the men with great faith in Hebrews. We can experience things unseen and miracles even more because of our faith.

Saturday, Nov 10: Jeremiah 29-32 Psalms 89

Scriptural Prayer: Blessed are those who have learned to acclaim you, who walk in the light of your presence, Lord. They rejoice in your name all day long; they celebrate your righteousness.

(Psalms 89:15-16)

My Prayer: Dear God, please bless the young generation who acclaim you, who walk in the light of your presence. You separate them apart from this world because You want them to be great testimonies to the world.

Healing Prayer: Sing to the Lord (Psalm 89:1-2)

When is the last time you sang a song to God? Let us sing to God a love song every day, to proclaim His faithfulness and love. We will experience the joy from the bottom of our heart when singing praise songs to Him!
